In the reference (vi) cited, Suguna International School, in Survey No. 226 & 227, Dr.Radhakrishnan Road, Doctor's Colony, Gandhipuram, Coimbatore District-641 012, Tamil Nadu run by "Suguna Charitable Trust" (Registered in Joint Sub-Registrar, Coimbatore, Reg. No. 128/1983) is accorded "Certificate of Recognition" upto 28.02.2019 for Classes LKG to VIIIth Std under section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act -2009 and Rule 12 & 13 of Tamil Nadu Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules - 2011 amended there under and the Tamil Nadu Recognised Private Schools (Regulation) Act 1973 and Rules 1974.

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

(1) The grant of recognition is available initially for classes LKG to VIIIth Std and to be extended for Secondary / Senior Secondary Classes subsequently in due course of time.

(2) The School shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamil Nadu Right of Children to

Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.

(3) The School shall admit in pre-school / class I to the extent of 25% of the strength in each class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

(4) The School shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of

reimbursement.

(5) The School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.

(6) The School shall not deny admission to any child, -

- (a) for lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
- (b) on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.

(7) The School shall ensure that,-

- no child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from School till the completion of elementary education in a school;
- no child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
- (iii) no child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
- (iv) every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 21.
- (v) inclusion of students with disabilities / special needs as per provision of the Act.
- (vi) the teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act: Provided that the teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years;

(vii) the teacher performs his duties specified under sub-section (1) of section 24 of the Act; and

(viii) the teacher shall not engage himself for private teaching activities.

(8) The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.

(9) The School shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Act.

 No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of School. 11) The School building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.

12) The School is run by a society registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1975), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;

13) The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of

individuals or any other persons;

14) The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent every year to the competent authority granting recognition.

15) The recognition Code Number shall be quoted for any correspondence with

the competent authority.

16) The School shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the School;

17) Tamil shall be taught as a subject from in Standards I to X in all schools notified under sub clause (iv) of clause (e) of section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Tamil Learning Act, 2006 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 2006) in a phased manner commencing from the academic year 2015-2016 for standard I, from the academic year 2016-2017 for standard I and II and shall be extended upto standard X in a like manner as ordered in a reference (5) cited as follows:

- (18) The school shall abide by the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Recognised Private Schools (Regulation)Act 1973 and Tamil Nadu Recognised Private Schools (Regulation) Rules 1974.
- (19)The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any stage/time.
- (20) The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities.
- (21) The Management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to this Directorate through the Chief Educational Officer of the district concerned.
- (22)The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/Department from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the School.
- (23)The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rules or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.
- (24)This order may be used only for the purpose of seeking affiliation to CBSE as requested by the management and the management is not entitled to seek affiliation to any other Board.
